Famee Furlane of Vancouver Post-Secondary Scholarship Award - 2025

This scholarship program is designed to provide a financial award to Famee Furlane members in good standing to further their full-time education or trades apprenticeship in any accredited, designated, or recognized Post-Secondary university, college or vocational institution that leads to a diploma, degree or Red Seal apprenticeship program. The applicant must begin the designated program by the end of the calendar year in which the award is received and can only receive the award once in their lifetime.

To qualify, the applicant must be a current member with over two years of good standing with the Famee Furlane of Vancouver. The successful applicant(s) will receive a \$1000 scholarship and will receive tickets for themselves and two guests to attend a banquet recognizing their achievement.

Applications may be obtained from the Famee Furlane of Vancouver office or downloaded from the website at www.fameefurlanevancouver.com/membership&events.

Scholarships will be awarded based on academic achievement, extracurricular activities, community service, and a 500 word essay describing their particular connection to Friulian culture and heritage. Additional consideration will also be given to applicants of families who are active in the association and to applicants who have volunteered or will volunteer with the Famee Furlane in the future. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to interview candidates, by phone or in person, in order to make a final determination.

Instructions:

- 1. This application is to be completed by students entering a full-time program of at least one year at a recognized Canadian university, college, technical institution, or recognized vocational institution or apprenticeship college. Current attendance at a Post-Secondary institution or trades apprenticeship program may already be in progress.
- 2. Complete all required information an incomplete application will not be considered.
- 3. Forward, by mail or delivery, the following completed application, along with relevant documents requested below, in a sealed envelope, to the **Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee**, Famee Furlane of Vancouver, 2605 East Pender Street, Vancouver, BC, V5K 2B6, no later than Monday, July 14th, 2025.

Applicants must provide:

- A final High School official transcript of marks for all secondary school grades completed or an
 interim transcript of marks for all secondary school grades completed and currently in progress.
 Transcripts and the interim report with marks must be signed and stamped by a school official.
- Resume
- Two reference letters: one from your community and one from your school
- Written statement, maximum 500 words, which must answer one of the following two questions:
 - 1) Describe your connection to the Famee Furlane and what it means to you to be of Friulian descent.

2) The composition of the Famee Furlane membership is aging. How do we ensure its continued existence and what specifically can youth do to keep it alive and strong?
